

Plaintiff Federal Trade Commission (“FTC”); Defendants Automators LLC, Empire Ecommerce LLC, Onyx Distribution LLC, Stryder Holdings LLC, Pelenea Ventures LLC, Roman Cresto, John Cresto, Andrew Chapman (collectively, “Defendants”); and Peregrine Worldwide, LLC (“Relief Defendant”) request a stay of all deadlines as to the FTC’s case against the Defendants and Relief Defendant in this matter until January 26, 2024, pending Commission review of a Stipulated Order for Permanent Injunction and Monetary Judgment as to Defendants and Relief Defendant. After consideration of the joint motion submitted in connection therewith, and for good cause shown, the Court **GRANTS** the joint motion to stay deadlines until January 26, 2024, while the proposed settlement is reviewed by the Commission.
